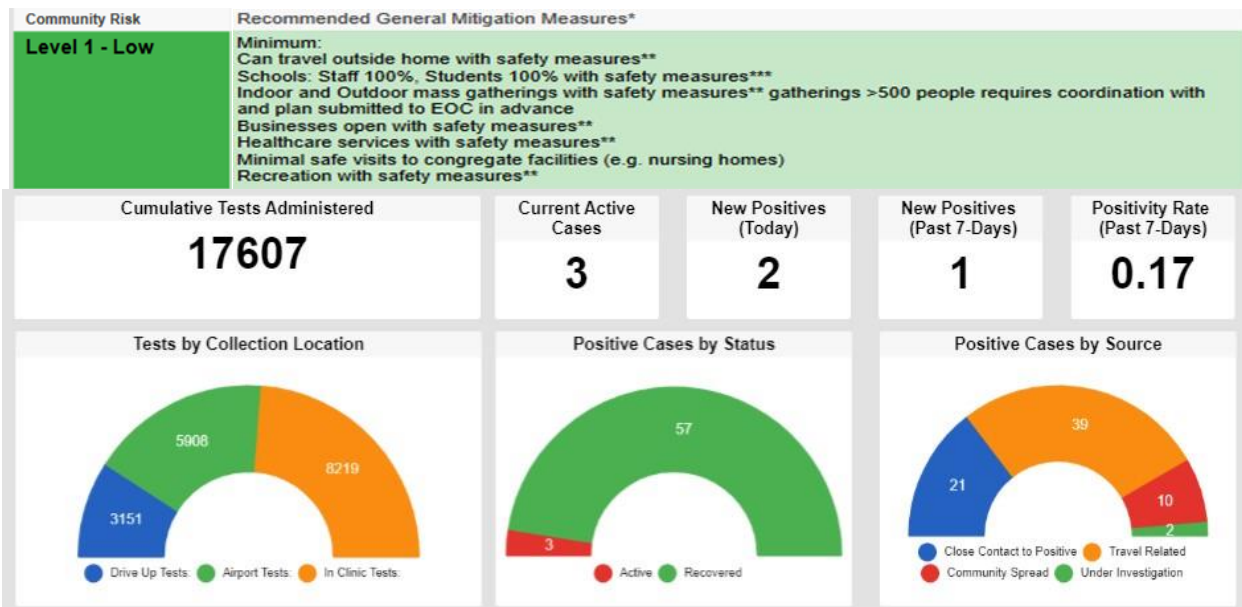
Two new cases were identified in Ketchikan today. Both individuals are from the same household, were symptomatic, and sought testing at a local health clinic. The cases are under investigation as to the source. The individuals have been notified of the positive test result, have been directed to isolate, and are being monitored by healthcare providers.

Public Health officials have begun the contact investigation and will reach out to any person who may have come into contact with this individual. Public Health will notify and quarantine additional persons as appropriate.

If you think you have been exposed to COVID-19 and develop any symptoms, no matter how minor—such as a fever, cough, or difficulty breathing—call your healthcare provider for medical advice or use the Testing Hotline and call 247-TEST (8378).

Today’s case brings the cumulative Covid-19 case count, including travelers, to 72. The number of positive cases of individuals residing or staying in Ketchikan is 60. Of the 60 cases, 3 are still active, and 57 have recovered.

Ketchikan’s Community Risk Level remains at Level 1 – Low.
